But they surely will write by Monday - tomorrow, August, 20th - Miss Lucy E. Sage, of Batavia did reply by today - Monday - she should conclude they had decided to postpone the day - so she now feels sure Mrs. Shaw will be free for Wyoming Monday night, Sept. 3d.

A letter from Laura Clay this A. M. says she will go to Niagara Falls for a day - before coming here the 29th. I wrote her yesterday she must plan to stop to go to you & to visit me leisurely after the B. C. meetings were over.
