Dear Anna E. Dann,

Here is Mrs. Harper's first report of herself – you see she is doing much at resting – that is a change of occupation for her – and that is really the rest we all need now and then --

Sister Mary has gone to an <u>Anthony</u> outing -- to north Greece– Mrs. Anthony & Maria and the two widows Anthony – Annie (?) & Mary -- they go to Mrs - Anthony's sisters – where they are to pick strawberries off the vines -- and have a good time generally. We expect our brother Daniel R. Anthony -- tomorrow – Thursday morning – to eat breakfast with us – take cracked wheat, Coffee and bread & butter & strawberries – the latter are

very nice now -- Home grown and down to 8 & 10 cts a box -- I have just dined alone – on potatoes, boiled egg, bread & butter and splendid berries -- and a cup of tea -- Lessie (?) has washed the attic windows this A.M. -- and now she is washing my office windows. – So you see we shall be quite cleaned up when you come back – but don't you come Monday because Mrs. Harper says she may come then— that is unless she invites you & come then – Best stay and have your visit and rest & ____ out --- now that you are there –Miss Heath has not reported yet – I am glad she is making her brother (?) such a good visit. I haven't seen Mr. Mason since I came home – I think he might call & report from you – though we got your postal yesterday -- Well -- take lots of comfort.
